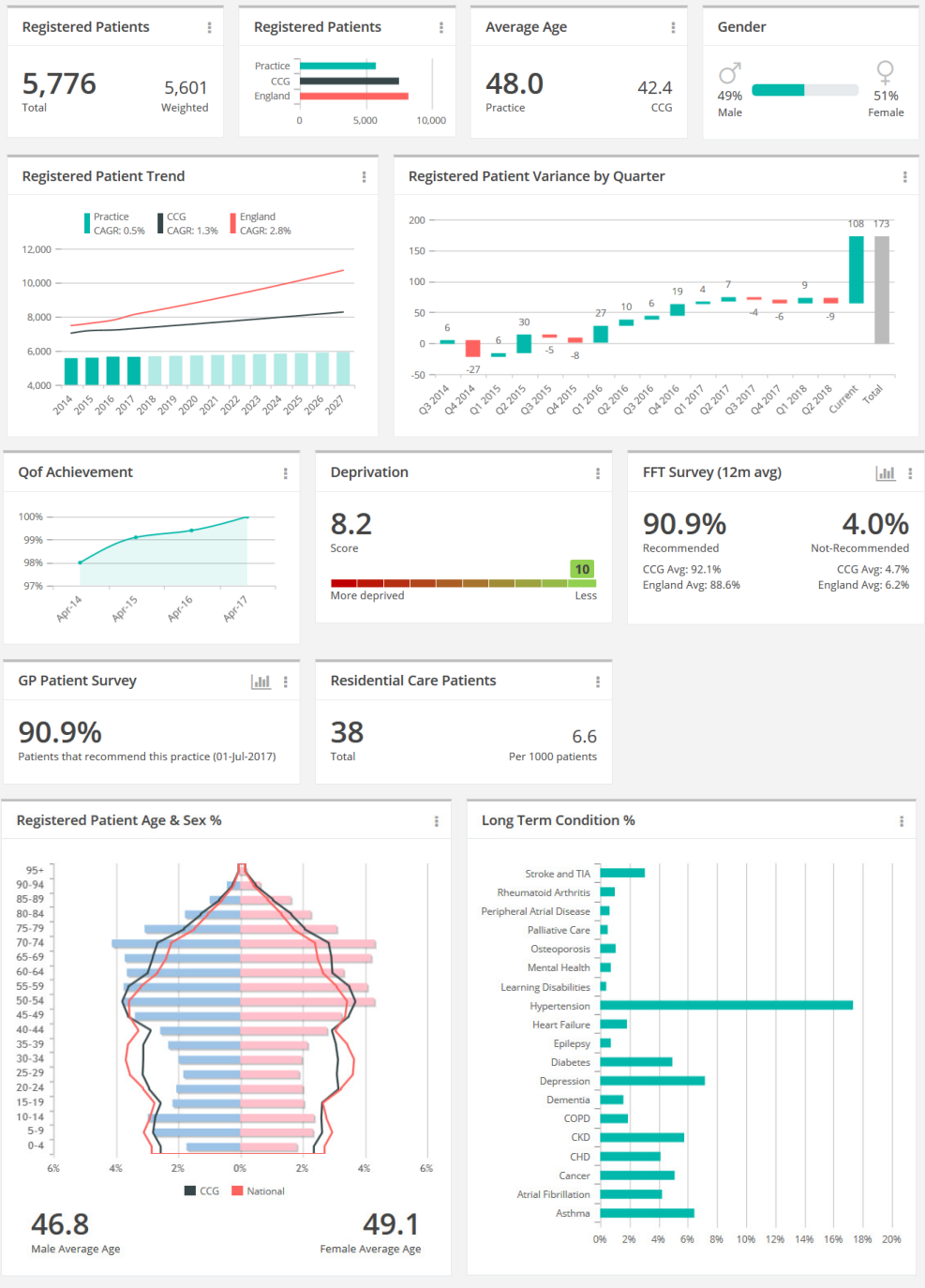

Our Practice

- Area – semi rural, including villages of Tarporley, Kelsall, Ashton, Tarvin and many more.
- Branch surgeries at Kelsall and Ashton
- Patient numbers 5826
- Demographics – 29% are over 65 years (CCG average 20%), 13% aged 75+
- Challenges – ageing population, isolation, poor transport links, new house building in area & more social housing

- New GP Contract on 1st July 2019 introducing Primary Care Networks
- Rural Alliance Primary Care Network
- Six local practices: Bunbury Medical Practice, Drs Adey & Dancy, Dr Campbell & Partners, Kelsall Medical Centre, Malpas Surgery and The Village Surgeries Group

Recent Developments in NHS Primary Care

- The Rural Alliance Primary Care Network Board consists of a GP and Practice Manager from each of the six practices
- Representatives from the Community Care Teams and Tarporley War Memorial Hospital attend for part of the Board Meetings
- The GP Contract sets out a workplan for the Primary Care Network over the next five years
